



Commercial Photography Policy at Southborough Open Land Foundation Properties

The Southborough Open Land Foundation (SOLF) is a private, non-profit land trust founded to preserve, protect, and enhance the natural resources in the Town of Southborough.

Certain SOLF properties may be used as sites for commercial photography. In order to provide the best experience and avoid conflicts with other visitors to the property, the photographer is required to email SOLF for permission in advance at info@solf.org. The request should include the name of the property, the date, and approximate time of the photo shoot.

The photographer, clients, and guests should park in the designated parking area for that property.

Any conduct which disturbs the tranquility of the property or its enjoyment by others is prohibited.

All commercial photographers shall be responsible for all the actions and activities of their party, and agrees to assume all liability for any property or personal damage resulting from their use of the property. The photographer shall hold the Trustees of SOLF harmless, and shall release the Trustees of SOLF of all liability, for any loss, injury, damage, illness, or expense as a result of or related to the use of the property.
